C.E.R.T.

(Community Emergency Response Team) We are "Neighbors helping Neighbors"

The recent Hurricane Ian has brought sharper into focus the need for CERT here in Bayshore Gardens. We were very lucky to have only sustained the minimal damage that we received but could have been much worse. When we are aware of a hurricane approaching it is too late to get the training and information necessary to protect yourself, your family and be able to assist your neighbors. That is when your CERT training becomes very important.

CERT is sponsored by Manatee County Emergency Management. Our instructors must be FEMA certified to teach the class. The classes are taught with all FEMA supplied materials so that the training is uniform nationwide. Once trained your ID is recognized nationwide. Visit at FEMA.GOV/CERT website for more information.

Our Bayshore Gardens CERT is growing. We will have four new members who are certified CERT t rained members but we need you.

We are just completing the CERT Basic Training Class and will schedule another class as soon as we have enough volunteers to take the training. The classes are free and can be held during the day or evenings for those who work. The training is about 24 hours broken down into 3 hour classes.

CERT training provides the necessary training to help your neighbors in a disaster and to better protect your family. You will receive lifesaving training as well as safe search and rescue. The time commitment once the training is completed is minimal. Most teams hold a monthly meeting lasting roughly an hour, a drill occasionally and activation in the event of an event such as a tornado, hurricane, or other natural disasters. When activated normally you would not be at work as most businesses shut down as well as shopping and other services. Our team members do not take time off from their work schedule'

You are invited to visit a CERT meeting or training session to learn more. Bayshore Gardens needs you to complete the team.

Veterans Day Facts

Veterans Day was originally called Armistice Day because it marked the one-year anniversary of the temporary cessation of hostilities between the Allied nations and Germany during World War I. That armistice went into effect at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918.

In 1926, Congress passed a resolution to make Veterans Day an annual occurrence, but it didn't become a federal holiday until 1938.

In 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower changed the name from Armistice Day to Veterans Day so it would honor all veterans rather than commemorate the end of a single war.

Officially, Veterans Day is always Nov. 11. But holiday office closures may shift when Veterans Day lands on a weekend. If Nov. 11 is a Sunday, businesses may observe the holiday the following day. If it lands on a Saturday, businesses might close on Friday instead.

Here's one of those obscure Veterans Day facts you can use to impress your friends: In 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Holidays Act, which put Veterans Day on the fourth Monday in October. It took effect in 1971, but in 1975, President Gerald Ford signed a law returning it to Nov. 11.

While Memorial Day honors Americans who died in the line of duty, Veterans Day commemorates all Americans who have served their country honorably, both living and deceased.

The 624-acre Arlington National Cemetery is home to the final resting place of more than 400,000 military service members and their families. As such, it holds an observance on Veterans Day every year at 11 a.m., the time the World War I armistice was signed.

Several other countries also mark the end of World War I on Nov. 11. Canada, Australia, France and Belgium call it Remembrance Day.
