RE: **Proposed Sprinkle Park for Preschoolers**

Last year I investigated the feasibility of putting in a "Sprinkle Park" for preschoolers. The Sprinkle Park would be in the grassy area to the right as you enter the pool facility.

I spoke to Jim Frost, former Chairman of the Board, Austin and Randy in maintenance, and Mike, the former Head Lifeguard. All individuals thought it was a fantastic idea. I also spoke to many parents with preschoolers and they likewise thought it would be perfect for younger children.

There is already water available in the grassy area, so no new plumbing is needed. The grassy area has both shaded and sunny sections and cement benches bordering it for parents to sit and watch their children.

I found several sprinkler systems designed for preschoolers. The area can accommodate up to 4 systems. Randy and Austin said it would be no problem removing the sprinklers to mow and then putting them*back.

The total cost for the "Sprinkle Park" would be under \$150, which I told Jim I would be paying for as a gift to Bayshore Gardens' youngest residents. Jim told me to go ahead and purchase the sprinkler systems, but never brought my planned gift of the Sprinkle Park before the Board for discussion and hopefully approval. Covid-19 put things on hold. Nonetheless, I would like to move ahead with the Sprinkle Park and seek Board approval to do so.

- 1. Provide a fun area for preschoolers to safely play and cool off.
- 2. The Sprinkle Park would require no financial investment from the District and no additional maintenance costs.
- 3. Having the Sprinkle Park within the pool area provides greater control over the area as the pool* facility is only accessible with a Fob. TO A MERCIAL AND A COLORIDA
- 4. It is close to the bathrooms.
- 5. Older children can use the pool and younger children the Sprinkle Park so families can all be in the same place at the same time.
