Update on Community Pool Closure

Dear Bayshore Gardens Residents,

The Board of Trustees understands and shares the frustration surrounding the extended closure of our community pool following Hurricanes Helene and Milton. We want to provide clarity on the delays and our ongoing efforts to resolve them.

The hurricanes left our grounds in disarray, requiring extensive cleanup before damage assessments could begin. Priority was initially given to the main clubhouse and hall, where a pre-scheduled hardwood floor restoration project in December demanded significant attention, including clearing the space and ensuring adequate air conditioning. This overlapped with pre-planned events that were scheduled before the restoration, further complicating our timeline.

In February 2025, we secured an application for a permit for the pool's electrical repairs as it was originally set up. After consulting with our electrician, the Board saw an opportunity to upgrade the electrical system to support future park expansion while addressing immediate needs. We also decided to relocate the meter and breaker to a higher elevation and additionally raise it to prevent future flood damage, as seen during Helene. However, per Manatee county, this new permit to relocate and raise, would need an in-person site inspection with Manatee county, FPL, and our contractor—a process that the county advised would delay the permit release by months due to county and FPL backlogs. A temporary electric line was applied for so we could at least get the pool operational while we went through the process, but this permit was denied. Our contractor and committee chair made several attempts to get an exception, but they had no luck.

To expedite reopening, we were advised, by the county, to revert to the original "remove and replace" permit, which we did, while also canceling the upgraded permit to avoid confusion per request of the county. Unfortunately, this placed our new application at the back of the county's queue (a three month wait), a detail that was not initially communicated and they would not compensate for. Further delays arose when Floodplain Management cited the FEMA 50% rule, mistakenly including the pool and marina gates, which have been entangled in some of the same delays. Now in June, after multiple rounds of clarifications from our committee chair, the county acknowledged this error, but then again stopped the permit, siting new requirements to raise the meter height—which would have aligned with our original plan from February, had we not been directed to change from that course.

The past several months have included multiple in person meetings at the county, multi person conference calls and countless emails and phone conversations. We are working tirelessly with our electrician, committee chair, Manatee county and office manager to navigate these challenges. We share your frustration and are pushing to expedite this process to reopen the pool as soon as possible.

As a side note the marina gate permit was finally released from being blocked at the county and is in the works.

Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Bayshore Gardens is a community of approximately 1406 single family homes located in southern portion of Manatee County along Sarasota Bay. In 1979, the Florida Legislature established Bayshore Gardens as an independent special taxing district. Special taxing Districts are special purpose governmental units that exist separately from local governments and are formed to perform a single function. Each resident of the District pays an annual assessment within their real estate taxes which funds the operational needs of the District. This annual fee is currently \$417. 
