Leak Detection Report: K. Weatherly stated that leaks were found in Zone 5 as well at Zone 4. Aqua Leak Detection gave an initial quote of \$4,400 for Gutter Port & Deck Repair. The price could go up depending on any other issues they run into, and the cost of any additional concrete. M. Raymer suggested to start at \$15,000 for any repairs needed to the pool. T. Zimmerly suggested to start at \$20,000. D. Rawlinson suggested to replum the whole pool. K. Weatherly stated that it would cost around \$200,000 to replum everything. K. Weatherly stated that Bayshore Gardens should redo it all instead of patching it up every year. Gia Cruz stated that the pool might not be open if all the plumbing were to be redone because businesses are so understaffed right now. B. Susdorf suggested a subcontractor come out and get an estimate and then decide. K. Weatherly stated he will try and get a subcontractor out to get an estimate on doing all the pipes before the next Board of Trustee's meeting on 01/26/2022. K. Weatherly suggested that if it takes a year or more to get all the pipes fixed, then they will look back into the original quote. K. Weatherly then made a motion for up to \$20,000 for pool repairs.
