Steve Porter from Duncan started they would still offer us a free boat lift if it's something that the Board would be interested in. This needs to go back to the Marina Committee.
- Tru-portal which is what handles all of our FOBS, gates and doors will be obsolete sooner rather than later. We are lucky everything is still running smoothly. Once Tru-Portal does an update the system will open all the doors and gates into the open position. I received a quote from AVP and to keep everything running with all the equipment we currently have other than the brains it would cost \$8,881.09.
