### **POOL PROGRESS**

#### Why is the pool closed?

The pool is closed for a complete re-plumbing and to bring the pool current to today's code requirements – Redoing the inside surface with new PebbleCrete, new tile, lights and updated steps and ladders,

#### Why wasn't this taken care of during the winter?

There were delays on both ends and by the time the contract was signed by both parties (contractor and Board of Trustees) it was the end of June and the contractors started the work at the end of July.

#### I heard there might be something wrong with how the contractor was hired, is this true?

The Board voted the pool renovation as an emergency project and with only one company that was available to do the scope of work and that was licensed and insured that the Board has covered themselves and the residents of the District from any legal issues.

#### What has been done so far?

The pool has been completely drained and the top layer of PebbleCrete (about an inch to an inch and a half) has been removed and disposed of from the entire pool. All of the surrounding tile has been removed and disposed of. The entire pool surface is getting prepped and ready for the new top layer of PebbleCrete to be applied.

# Is the Board required to have the residents' permission/approval to spend this money to repair the pool?

It is the Boards fiduciary responsibility to maintain the District grounds and this includes the swimming pool. The pool is original (about 60 years old) and the Board tried repairing the leaks with patch jobs, but in the end, it was financially responsible for the Board to make the needed repairs and cheaper if it was all done at once instead of in stages (which would have taken longer and cost the District more money). Per the Bayshore Garden's Charter and our attorney's opinion after reading the Charter the 2/3 vote and referendum requirement only applies to the acquisition of real or tangible personal property by the District. Since we are not changing the layout or moving the pool to a different location, the Board is completely in its rights to maintain the pool (what is already there without adding anything now or additional) without approval or permission from the residents.
