Manatee County Government is developing a vision for US 41 – Tamiami Trail in Manatee County, from Cortez Road south to the Sarasota County line. The project aims to create a plan for a recognizable gateway to enhance the visual appeal, functionality, and neighborhood identification of this key corridor, fostering a vibrant, welcoming environment for residents, businesses, and visitors alike.

Potential improvements to the corridor may include landscaping, hardscaping, medians, pedestrian upgrades, transit amenities, etc. The County is also considering potential amendments to the County's land development regulations to improve opportunities for redevelopment along the corridor.

Marlene said that in lieu of eating at Anna Maria Oyster Bar, we are invited by Joyce Fisher to Sarasota Sands, (2150 Ben Franklin Drive, Sarasota, FL 34236) for our May 5 event (lunch is provided at 1:00). Of course, we are welcome to take time to explore nature and walk along the beach or swim in the pool. There were six or seven members that said they will attend the event, so far. We need to know the number to have lunch ordered in.

Marlene said that we need people to volunteer to organize the September and November Meetings (September 8th and November 3rd). Melanie Woodruff said she will take the September date. It was noted that Melanie had signed up for refreshments on that date. Terry Zimmerly said she will help with the September refreshments. We still need ideas for November.

We 'broke' to enjoy some refreshments provided by Kathy Rowe. Kathy was thanked for the refreshments. We presented a (signed) Birthday Card for Matilda Renovalez and cupcakes were provided by Kathy Rowe.

Marlene Durgin moved that the Club maintain a flower bed at the Recreation Park. Melanie Woodruff seconded the motion. The motion passed on vote. There was a suggestion that a sign 'Sponsored by Bayshore Garden Club' be posted.

We adjourned at 1:25 for the presentation.

Suzanna Young introduced Travis Newell of Terry's Tree Service (941 748 4484), for a presentation on tree trimming. Terry's Tree Service has served clients in Manatee and Sarasota counties since 1984. Travis said that he is a ISA Certified Arborists and the company is a TCIA Accredited company. Travis said he has been an arborist for 10 to 12 year, ACI Professional, International Society of Arboriculture.

Terry's Tree Service can help in Preparation for hurricanes. Travis stated that last year none of their prepared trees fell due to the storms.

ISA certified Arborists valid for 3 years. You can check credentials online (<https://www.treesaregood.org/findanarborist/findanarborist>)

Travis stated that one error in trimming trees is called 'Lion's Tail' which makes the branches look like a lion's tail -letting the limbs whip in the wind. It is better to make the limbs shorter or leave the interior branches. It is not a good idea to 'top' a tree as the new growth from nodes at the cuts will have a weak attachment and be a problem later. Look for (and correct) any crossing/rubbing branches, and dead wood.

Spanish moss will not kill a tree. Staghorn may harbor wetness on the tree which can promote decay.

They have added cable bracing (steel rods and steel cables) in the canopy. Cable bracing helps brace an area of the tree. Leaning trees can be propped.

GARDEN CLUB MINUTES - CONTINUED

Compacted soil may cause a sick tree. Their service will blow out soil and replace. Tree roots need air.

Palm trimming— palm fronds should be cut between 3:00 and 9:00, not higher.

Palm disease – Basal stem rot (BSR) in palms or **Ganoderma zonatum** - forms a fungus/'concks' at the base of the trunk. The disease rots the lower trunk and roots leading to palm death. Characterized by wilting and off-color fronds. Prevent this by keeping the palm healthy, as there is no cure.

Lethal bronzing infects the canary and date and other palms. It is a bacteria carried by an insect that will kill a palm in months. Removal is recommended.

Preparing for upcoming storms is encouraged early. Scheduling a 'visit' can take 6 to 10 weeks. An assessment and action can reduce damage. Quotes are free. Consultations may cost.

In 1979, the Florida Legislature established Bayshore Gardens as an independent special taxing district. Special taxing Districts are special purpose governmental units that exist separately from local governments and are formed to perform a single function. Each resident of the District pays an annual assessment within their real estate taxes which funds the operational needs of the District. This annual fee is currently \$417. We are not an HOA, although we have a voluntary Club called the HOA which a resident may join for an annual fee of \$10.

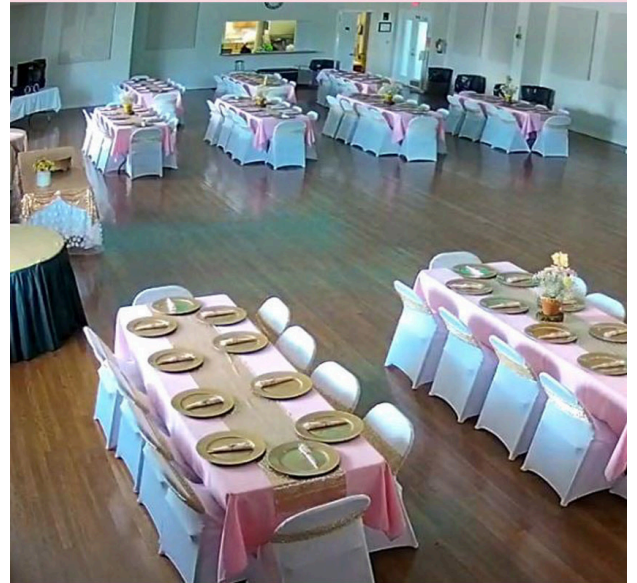
