Eighteen attended the informative presentation We learned about several of orchid species (Vandas, Dendrobiums, Cattleyas, Oncidiums, Paphiopedilum, and Phalaenopsis) and hybrids. We admired the orchids everywhere and throughout the growing houses. Many of us purchased an orchid or two of our choice.

### Did you know?

- Orchids can live longer than people.
- Most orchids have just one corresponding fungus they can consume.
- Some orchids want full sun others just bright light.
- Some orchids are very fragrant.
- Some want to stay damp while others want to dry between rains/watering.
- Horticulturist and collectors keep a 'stud book' of their plants' heritage. (So...keep the plant's tag.)
- Some orchids like sphagnum, some tightly packed sphagnum, while others do not need any medium.
- Some orchids grow so tall that the plant should be tied near the bottom of the tree or structure.
- We had a wonderful visit and learned a great deal. If you get a chance, visit Palmer Orchids. Palmer Orchids is holding an Open House March 10, 11, and 12.


