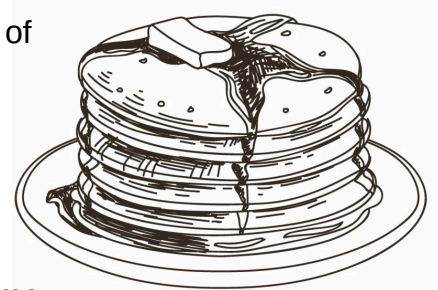

The Bayshore Gardens Park and Recreation District is a Special Taxing District created by the Legislature of Florida. Our Rec. Center property is governed by a nine-person Board of Trustees to maintain the District. We are one of the few subdivisions who actually have the right to vote on the Budget which is presented to us each Spring. (FEW resident homeowners actually vote) The annual assessment is collected by Manatee County Tax Collector on the real estate tax bill.

**UPDATES FROM THE MANAGER:** The holidays are over, decorations are down and put away for another year. We are settling into what we hope to be a good, productive year! As much of you may have noticed the District grounds have not looked the same since we were hit by the two back to back hurricanes. The Board is working hard to get things back to the way they were before the storms. At the Special Meeting that was held on January 15th, the Board passed, getting all new electric re-ran to the main building (office and rec. hall) and the swimming pool. The pool will be drained, cleaned, and new pumps put in to get the pool back up and running. The Board also passed replacing the roof on the recreation hall as it is not repairable due to the storm damage. We are still working on getting other quotes, especially in the marina, to get everything back up and running like it should be. You should see these projects starting in February. The Board and all of the employees here are working hard to get your District grounds to a place where all the residents can come and enjoy.

# The Bayshore Gardens District Welcomes You

Bayshore Gardens is a community of approximately 1406 single family homes located in southern portion of Manatee County along Sarasota Bay. In 1979, the Florida Legislature established Bayshore Gardens as an independent special taxing district. Special taxing Districts are special purpose governmental units that exist separately from local governments and are formed to perform a single function. Each resident of the District pays an annual assessment within their real estate taxes which funds the operational needs of the District. This annual fee is currently \$417. We are not an HOA, although we have a voluntary Club called the HOA which a resident may join for an annual fee of \$10.

CERT BASIC TRAINING CERTIFICATION COURSE for Bayshore Gardens is available to our residents and there is never a charge for the training. Hurricane season starts soon, and we need more trained volunteers for Bayshore Gardens. CERT volunteers are trained in first aid, search and rescue, fire, and safety. CERT operates under the sponsorship of Manatee County, Homeland Security, and FEMA. We are required to have the approved training to participate in the program. The commitment is for about 24 hours of classroom instruction. The classes are broken down into 4 hours segments.

We are also offering HAM radio licensing classes in preparation for the Technician Level exam. Classes will be from 6-7pm in the Trailer Estates Activity building. Class dates will be Monday 2/3; Friday 2/7; Monday 2/10 and Friday 2/14. The Technician Level exam will be on Saturday 2/14. If you are interested, I will need your Name, Phone # and email address. You do not have to be a CERT member to take the class. I now have to charge \$5 to cover my materials for the class. In addition, there will be a \$15 to take the exam and (I believe) \$35 for the license. I need at least 5 or 6 to make the class go. Once I have names and contact information, I will send out directions, map, etc. To enroll or for more information please call 517-204-1780 or email [Smithdpjr44@outlook.com](mailto:Smithdpjr44@outlook.com)

CERT is a self-activating arm of Manatee County disaster response. We live in the community, and we know the community. We report to Manatee County Emergency Management by cell phone, or HAM radios

to get the help we need in a disaster. The real problem in a hurricane is the loss of cell towers and power. CERT is able to communicate to request help even if the power and cell towers are down, we can get help to members of the community.

Bayshore Gardens is currently paired with Trailer Estates until we can get enough members trained to cover our District. The need in Bayshore is great. Once trained the time spent with CERT is minimal. We meet once a month, (not mandatory to attend) and hold drills to be better prepared for an emergency. The drills last less than an hour and are only held a couple of times a year. (Attendance not mandatory). Our monthly meetings include short refresher training from a medical person.

The Command Center for our CERT is currently in Trailer Estates, Activity building (Pool) use north door for entrance in an emergency. We are there to help but would like to have the same Command Center for Bayshore Gardens when we have enough volunteers certified.

## SATURDAY WORKSHOPS

There was discussion on the condition of the tools and the shop. We have set several Saturday workshops to clean up / clean out the shop and work on the flood-damaged tools. Once we are done, we should have a functioning shop, but maybe fewer tools.

The air stapler (gun) is still missing. Borrowers need to RETURN borrowed tools.

As discussed at the meeting - all the stand-alone tools are essentially the district's. When a tool is deemed 'surplus'/ unwanted, a letter is sent to the District House and Grounds Committee to advise them the need for 'them' to dispose or sell it.

A letter was sent in July 2024 concerning the old planer and the old planer still sits in our shop (tagged). We would like the 'surplus'/unwanted tools stored somewhere else, perhaps in the maintenance shop or shed. There may be more damaged tools to be disposed of soon -unless we can fix them.

Equipment problems? If there is any problem with a tool, please notify an officer and leave a note/tag on the tool. Tags are on top of the metal cabinet along the north wall. All flood damaged tools are tagged stating the same.

2025 club officers' phone numbers are listed on the front window. Use safety equipment when using any power tool. shop users are required to sign-in at the door and clean up after using the shop.

2025 memberships are available at the recreation center office during normal hours. 2025 memberships are \$30, cash, and expire at the January 2026 meeting.

Our next scheduled Meeting is Saturday, March 8, 2025, at 10 am in the shop. We hope to see you at the meeting.

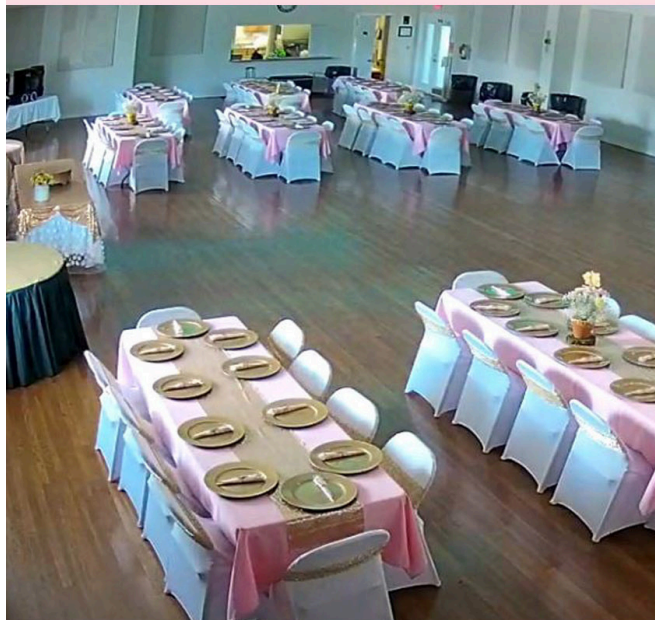
