### **Pricing Estimates for Heating & Cooling of the pool**

Received an estimate from SolarSource to heat the pool with solar heating. The cost was between \$115,000 and \$125,000. This is comparable to the heating <u>and cooling</u> of the pool using the geothermal heat pump system. Solar is likely more cost-intensive to maintain and will not fully address the cooling of the pool in the Summer. Suggest we go with the estimate that Cori obtained for the geothermal heat pump system.

#### Price Estimate for Children's Splash Pad from Aquatix (via email)

I asked for an estimate for a small 1,200 sq. ft. area (I used the grassy area near the pool pumps). It was difficult to provide an estimate based on the measurements, they thought we could get some features and a system installed for maybe \$50,000 (minimum). While the company does not install the concrete pad, they estimated that to be another \$10-\$15,000. I would put the estimate at \$75,000 just to be safe.




- Food trucks

- Boat lifts at the marina (installed by district, paid for through increased fees for the slip)





How many persons live at your address? 327 responses
